Penge Churches Housing Association (PCHA) is a small community-based housing association. PCHA was established by local churches in 1969 in response to a growing awareness of the housing problem in and around Penge. In the wake of "Cathy Come Home" the churches identified a need for good-quality affordable housing in the local area and worked together with the community to respond to that need. After 50 years based in Bromley borough, PCHA completed a transfer of engagements from Bexley Community HA, in 2023 resulting in us owning 400+ homes across Bromley and Bexley. From July 2024 we entered into a Management Contract with LB Bromley to manage their housing stock including temporary accommodation.

Our main purpose is to provide good-quality homes and housing services in the local community. Our properties and services aim to meet a range of needs in our community, including working with people with mental health problems and learning disabilities.

Our aim is to make a difference every day and have a positive impact on both the lives of our tenants and the communities in which we work. We are committed to working in partnership with our tenants to ensure that their tenancies and our communities are sustainable.
